Mission Reflection - Small Group Questions

Tuesday, August 18

1. The long term shut down of in-person gatherings, the rapid economic shifts and changes in interpersonal behavior have created a "Reset Moment" for society. In terms of congregational/ community life and moving toward virtual gatherings and other forms of connection- How has your congregation/ diocese/ community changed? What opportunities are there to reset the system? What changes are evolving and how might they inform your future community?
2. Moving out of the "emergency phase" of leadership into a time when some adaptive work can begin to happen: How has this time of improvisational leadership informed your next steps? How are you getting on the balcony to have a longer-term view?
3. If you could start your ministry from scratch after the pandemic what would it look like? How would it be different from pre-pandemic life?
4. Evangelism requires vulnerability when so much about our current pandemic situation feels unnaturally constrained. How can we foster true vulnerability in constrained circumstances so that those who may not know God can see a bit of God in us and our relationships, maybe at least enough to be curious about pursuing their own relationships with God and maybe even the church?
